## Safety Task Card STCBG 15

### Safe System of Work

1. You must wear disposable gloves when handling fuel.
2. Safety goggles must be worn in case of splash back.
3. Only refuel equipment in a designed well-ventilated area, away from sources of ignition and in the shade.
4. Do not smoke or use a mobile phone while handling fuel.
5. Ensure a spill kit is available and within easy access.
6. Always refuel over a drip tray or plant nappies.
7. Equipment must be turned off.
8. Allow equipment that has recently been used to cool down before refueling.
9. Where appropriate use a funnel.
10. Clean up any spillages immediately. Small spillages can be wiped up and a spill kit must be used for larger spills.
