MONTHLY SAFETY FOCUS

Slips & falls

Remember that as the weather starts to change it is important that we take extra care when walking and moving around our units as well as coming in and out of work. Be aware of water build up at entrances and exits of your buildings and workspaces. Ensure that we have mats in place where possible and signage in place to warn team members, customers and clients of any hazards. Check your footwear, is it appropriate and providing suitable slip resistance? Ensure that any defects in flooring or in structure leading to leaks are reported appropriately and followed up.



SEE

Standing water, damaged floors, leaks and poor lighting.



CARE

Clear hazards promptly. Use mats and warning signs.



SHARE

Report defects and wear slip-resistant footwear.

- 04 ASSESS & ACT** Complete ES09b and address concerns
