Safe System of Work

- 1. You must wear reinforced toe cap safety shoes.
- 2. Follow the safety precautions in the COSHH Product Assessments for the paint and any cleaning products being used. This includes wearing PPE such as protective eyewear and gloves.
- 3. Implement safe manual handling practices when lifting paint and water containers to fill line marker.
- 4. When preparing paint from a concentrate, water should always be added first, then the paint.
- 5. Ensure the controls on STCGE 32 are implemented when charging batteries.
- 6. Do not open any pipe joints while the pump is on when using pressurized line markers.
- 7. Do not pour left over paint mix onto grass surfaces, down drains or info water courses.
- 8. When rinsing equipment do this over a suitable container to catch wastewater and ensure that it cannot enter water courses.

If you have any concerns, stop and speak with your line manager before proceeding
