


## What are the hazards and how might they harm?







Fire caused by accidental ignition of flammable items

## Safe System of Work

- 1. Only use the equipment in a well-ventilated area and on a level surface.
- 2. Use equipment away from flammable materials.
- 3. Always fit or change gas cartridges in a well-ventilated area away from any naked flames or, where practicable, outside in the open air.
- 4. Never put a gas canister down on or near to a hot surface or ignition source.
- 5. Hold the equipment in an upright position when lighting it.
- 6. Always use a long-reach lighter.
- 7. Light the flame as soon as the gas is turned on.
- 8. Never leave the equipment unattended when lit.
- 9. Never use equipment if it is leaking gas or malfunctioning.
- 10. After use, make sure that the gas control knob is fully turned off.
- 11. Allow the hot parts to cool, remove the gas cartridge and then store immediately in a secure, cool (below 50°C), well-ventilated place out of direct sunlight and at least one metre away from any flammable materials and ignition sources.
- 12. Never attempt to repair or modify the equipment.

If you have any concerns, stop and speak with your line manager before proceeding.
