ECOLAB CHEMICAL SAFETY INFORMATION UPDATED

We are continuously reviewing and refining our safety information. In light of this, we have engaged in extensive collaboration with our primary supplier of chemical and cleaning products, Ecolab, to enhance the safety information for all the offerings they provide.



As a result of this work carried out there has been a total review and update of all the Ecolab Chemical Product Assessments as well as the Chemical Safety Task Cards. All units must ensure that over the next two months they review and update their Chemical Product Inventories. Once your Inventories are updated, you should then visit the Chemical Safety Pages on the HSE Website, print off and make available the update Chemical Product Assessments and Chemical Safety Task Cards. Remember that the Chemical Safety Task Cards should also be displayed in the unit where regular chemical usage or tasks are carried out as an aid to team members. If you require any advice or further guidance please contact your Sector HSE Manager.

SAFE USE OF CHEMICALS - REMINDER OF CONTROLS

We are seeing a sharp increase in incidents involving chemicals, some of which have resulted in significant injuries to our team members. It is important that we continuously remind ourselves and each other of the rules of chemical safety. Where the Safety Task Card mandates the wearing of PPE, this is for good reason, which is that there is a risk of harm that can only be controlled by the use of the PPE. So when you are dispensing or using chemicals and you are told to wear gloves or goggles, then please do so. Just like you wear a seatbelt in a car and if you were in an accident, it could save your life. By wearing your PPE and following the safety instructions you can help to prevent significant injury when using chemicals.

The Rules of Chemical Safety

- · Use the right chemical for the job
- Use protective clothing and equipment if required
- Add chemical to water NOT water to chemical always follow procedures
- Report anything wrong to your supervisor (damaged containers, spills)
- · Store all chemicals safely and in original containers. Safely dispose of empty containers
- · Always read the product label and know where to find the safety data sheets
- Be sure you know what first aid treatment is required if you accidentally spill chemicals on yourself or others
- · Don't mix chemicals. Mixing chemicals can kill
- · Never taste or smell chemicals
- · Never use unknown chemicals

As always, we have created a Safety Conversation on this topic and this month there is a couple of posters to print and display in locations where chemicals are used and dispensed.


