Unit Managers – use page overleaf to list any hazards and control measures specific to your site which are not listed below

- Only use the equipment if you have been trained to do so and always follow the manufactures' instructions.
- Only use the equipment for the intended purpose: steaming fabrics.
- Always ensure that the water tank is full and firmly closed before using the appliance.
- Don't add hot water into the water tank, which can cause the deformation of the water tank.
- Keep the cable behind the line of work and arranged in a way that does not represent a trip hazards.
- Never direct the steam jet towards people and keep hands away from the steam jet.

- 10. While in use, only hold the appliance by the handle and keep hands away from the steaming head and any
- 11. Take regular breaks when using the steamer on large areas or for extended periods.
- 13. Turn equipment off before changing accessories or filling the water tank.
- 14. After use make sure all the water is drained using the drain plug on the bottom of the unit to eliminate standing
- 15. Clean up spillages as they occur and use wet floor warning signs when appropriate.

If you have any concerns, stop and speak with your line manager before proceeding.
