

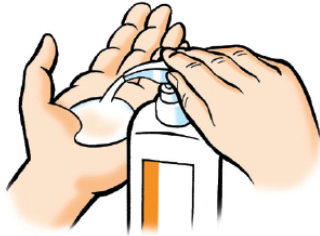

An alcohol hand gel can be used to rapidly decontaminate physically clean hands of germs as a quick, effective alternative to hand washing. Alcohol can kill germs on your hands but cannot clean them. If your hands are visibly soiled you must perform a full handwash. Follow these six steps every time you decontaminate your hands to ensure that the gel covers all areas:

1



Apply the gel to the palm of one hand

2



Press fingertips of the other hand to the palm

3



Tip the remaining alcohol from one palm to the other

4



Press fingertips of the other hand to the palm

5



Quickly spread alcohol onto all surfaces of both hands, paying particular attention to thumbs

6



Continue spreading the alcohol until it dries
