Procedure	
Stage 1	Ensure the area is well ventilated
Stage 2	Sprinkle directly on to the products surfaces that are being joined
Stage 3	Or mix 1-part Activa EB with 5-parts water to make a slurry
Stage 4	Use a brush to paint surfaces that are being joined
Stage 5	Join surfaces
Stage 6	Wash hands after removing gloves
